

Gender Differences Among UAE University Students Due to Globalization An Empirical Descriptive Study

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Abstract

Based on clinical experience, the author introduces a newly developed Clinical Sociology perspective to evaluate the impact of American Globalization on UAE Personality. The study explores gender differences among a sample of college students from the national university at UAE. The author contends that Globalization is neither recent nor confined to the West. Current Globalization has been conceived as a cultural Global interaction and social change process through which a new seven personality types have emerged. It is the author's intention is to explore into the dynamics of personality, identity, in an attempt to evaluate the status of UAE Society due to American Globalization, The authors hypothesis is that Globalization effect on men is different than that on women.
