- Collect blood sample (sterile and routine),evaluate the result reporting abnormal value to physician in intensive care units.
- Daily checking the various life support equipment , working or not as the patients life depends on this equipment as (ventilator machine , dropper machine , monitors).
- Doing rounds with senior doctors and document notes the order for each patient .
- Prepare equipment and kept ready during each shift as emergency tray,crash cart, intubation tray.
